COURSE INFORMATION

This course applies to workers in residential facilities. These workers carry out activities related to maintaining an individual's wellbeing through personal care and/or other activities of living. Occupational titles may include but are not limited to accommodation support worker, care team leader, care supervisor, residential care worker, support worker, day activity worker, assistant coordinator, or personal care worker.

PRE-REQUISITES

Students are required to obtain a current clear Victorian Police Check and Working with Children Check to complete this course.

PATHWAYS

Direct pathways from this qualification are Certificate IV in Leisure and Health or becoming a Registered Nurse (RN) or Enrolled Nurse (EN).
