Expected Self-Paced Study Hours

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Course Information

This qualification is for those workers who would like to work in the Aged Care sector in a community or aged care facility setting, students will be taught to follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. The work involves using discretion and judgment in relation to individual support. Workers will have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support. Workers are required to obtain a current clear Victorian Police Check and Working with Children Check. If you have any concerns please speak to our friendly staff.

Pathways

Direct pathway's from this qualification include Certificate IV in Ageing Support, Certificate IV in Leisure and Health and Certificate IV in Disability.

Fees and Charges
