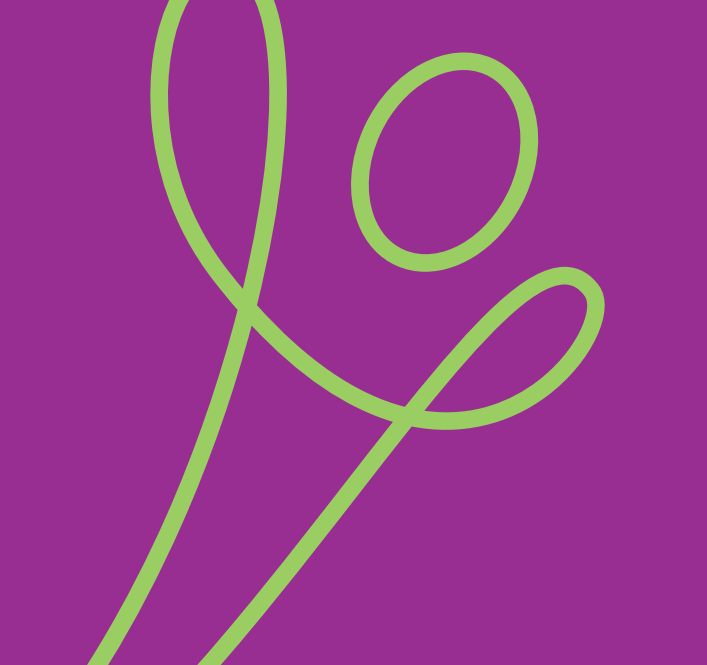
Beginner (Full Study Model) No recent related Self-paced study hours expected approximately 14 hours per week
