This course is for those seeking to become a support worker in a range of community settings and clients' homes, who provide training and support in a manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self-reliance, community participation and wellbeing.

Workers promote a person-centred approach, work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a small team.

PRE-REQUISITES

Students are required to obtain a current clear Victorian Police Check and Working with Children Check to complete this course.

PATHWAYS

Direct pathways from this qualification are Certificate IV in Ageing Support or Certificate IV in Leisure and Health.
